Thank you to our guest musician for the month of July, Elizabeth Tipton.

Elizabeth Tipton, a native of Wisconsin, moved to New York for music school and remained in the New York area for 30 years, performing as a soloist, chamber music partner, accompanist, and teacher, raising a family along with her fellow musician husband, Noel Tipton. Since 1988 they have lived in Eastham and taken active roles performing in many musical endeavors and teaching at Cape Cod Conservatory as well as other musical centers, while Noel was also busy in theater, having started at the Eventide Arts Festival in Dennis. It was early in their lives that they met Roy Campbell, while teaching at the conservatory – the beginning of a warm friendship.

Thank you to today's guest trumpet soloist, Kyle Spraker.

Kyle Spraker joined the Cape Symphony trumpet section in 2014, becoming Principal Trumpet in 2017. In addition to serving on Cape Symphony faculty as a private trumpet instructor, Kyle also manages the Cape Symphony Youth Orchestra Program and all Cape Symphony educational concerts, like the annual *Young People's Concerts* and *Link Up*. Outside of the Cape Symphony and various local ensembles, Kyle can be heard frequently with New Bedford Symphony Orchestra and Plymouth Philharmonic. He also performs regularly with his wife, Maria, often arranging music for trumpet and harp. Kyle and Maria moved to Cape Cod in 2017 and both currently work at the Cape Symphony as performers, teachers, and administrators. Kyle holds a master's degree from the New England Conservatory of Music and Bachelor's Degree from California State University: Long Beach. He credits his success as an orchestral musician to the incredible training he received from members of both the Boston Symphony Orchestra and Los Angeles Philharmonic trumpet sections.
