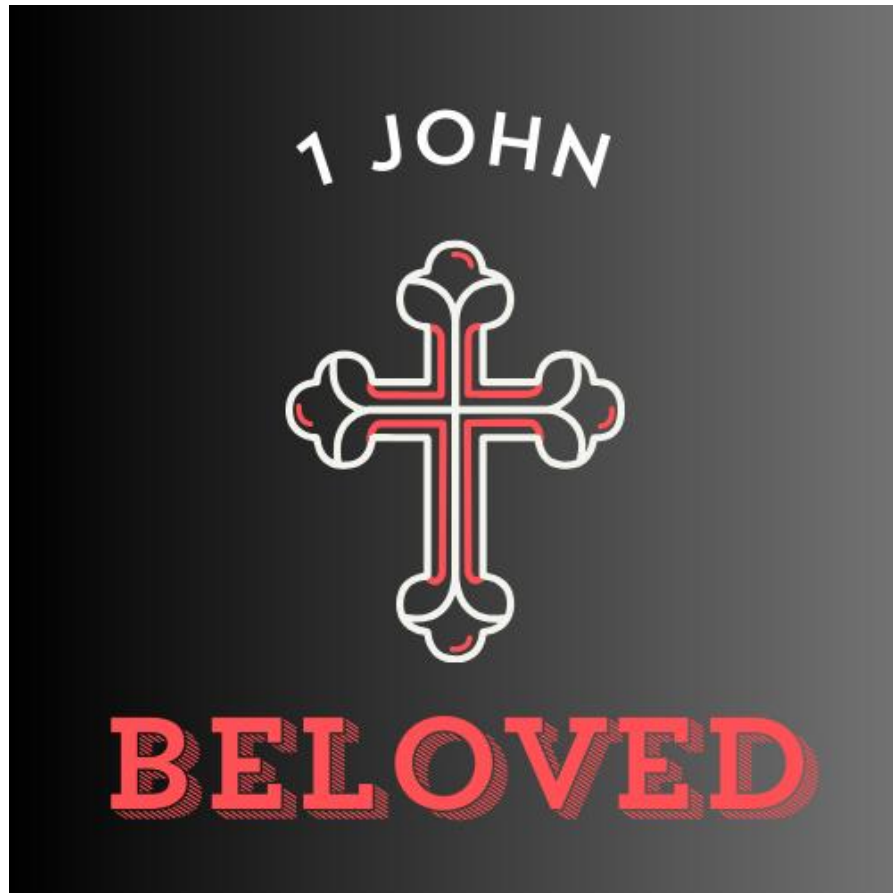

I John 2:15-17: It's Your World...I'm Just Living in It
