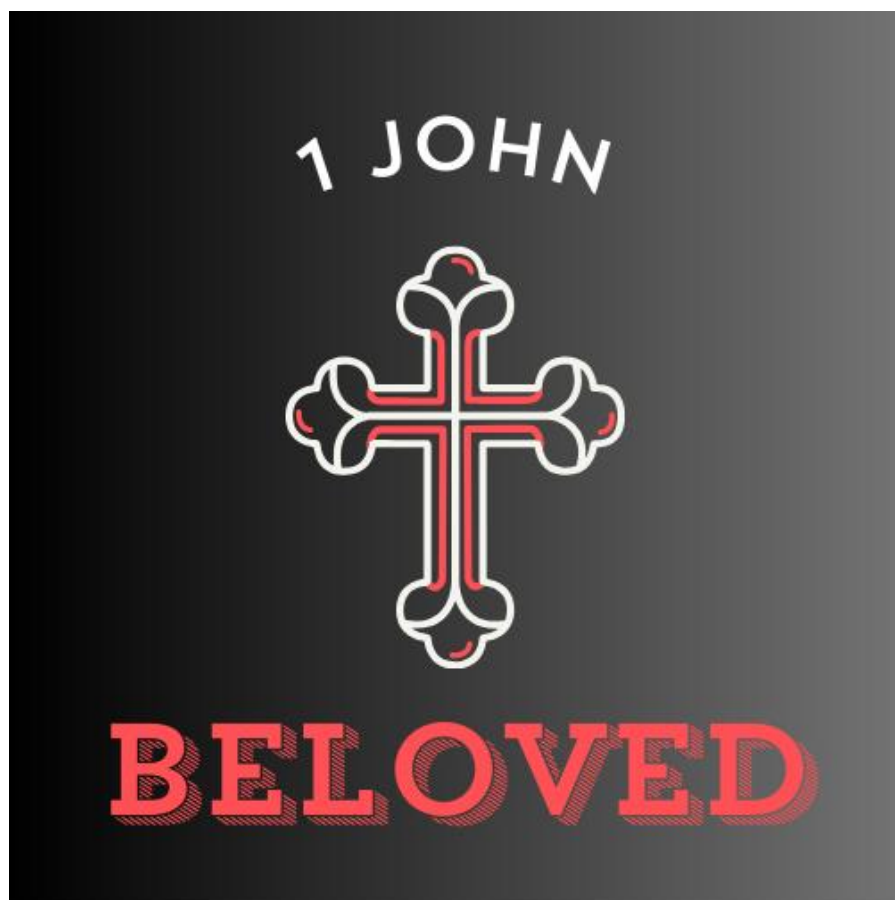

ROOTED RESOURCES for “I John 3:11-15 & II John 1-6 - All You Need Is LOVE”

1. John begins this passage—and says essentially the same thing in II John—with a reminder to the church that the message he is preaching is one that they’ve heard from the beginning: to love one another. Why the emphasis on loving each other? How does this fit into being a Christ-follower?

2. In II John, he gives us another aspect of love: that we obey and walk in His commands. In other words, love encompasses obedience and servant hood. What does that look like for you? What are we supposed to obey and how is that lived out?

3. Read the story of the brothers Cain and Abel in Genesis 4. What are your initial thoughts and reflections on the story? Why does Cain get angry? How does God deal with his sacrifice? How does Cain react and what does it—ultimately—lead to? How is that a reflection of us today?
