

PASSING OF THE PEACE WITH THE CONGREGATION PRESENT AND ONLINE

CALL TO WORSHIP (all) *from Psalm 40:1-11*

Pastor: I waited patiently for the Lord; he inclined to me and heard my cry. He drew me up from the pit of destruction, out of the miry bog, and set my feet upon a rock, making my steps secure.

People: He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God. Many will see and fear, and put their trust in the Lord.

Pastor: Blessed is the man who makes the Lord his trust, who does not turn to the proud, to those who go astray after a lie!

People: I have not hidden your deliverance within my heart; I have spoken of your faithfulness and your salvation; I have not concealed your steadfast love and your faithfulness from the great congregation.

All: As for you, O Lord, you will not restrain your mercy from me; your steadfast love and your faithfulness will ever preserve me!
